


TOP RISKS FACING RECREATIONAL VEHICLE DEALERS



Claims trends*

The number of RV dealer claims has increased by 63% over the last three years and the average claims cost has increased by 57% compared to the previous three-year period. Theft is the leading type of loss for RV dealers and account for 24% of all losses, follow by vehicle collision (17%), weather-related events such as wind and hail storms (14%) and fire (10%).
